

Bursaries at Clifton College

The College bursary system is administered on our behalf by Bursary Assessment Associates, an independent company. This is a means tested process which looks to consider each family's circumstances and the affordability of school fees.

Parents will be required to:

- · Fill in an online application form
- · Provide supporting documents
- · Attend a virtual meeting with a member of the BAA team to discuss your application

Bursaries will be reassessed annually to make sure that all assistance provided is appropriate and in-line with our charitable objectives. The College will make contact to start the renewal process and aim to confirm bursary offer by the start of the Summer Term.

Who is eligible to apply?

As a guide, the following criteria may be used by the BAA as households that may be eligible for bursarial support.



Both parents working (unless prevented from doing so through illness or the need to care for dependents)



Ownership of only one property (with a mortgage) or living in rented accomodation



Combined gross income of up to 4 x school fees (depending on day/ boarding)

The following would not be consistent with a bursary:



Frequent and/or expensive holidays



New or luxury cars



Investment in significant home improvements
