

11+ Scholarships for September 2021 entry

During the course of Year 6 there are three 11+ Scholarships assessments held; Sport, Academic and Music. This letter provides more details on each of the three Scholarships including application and assessment dates. If you would like to put your son or daughter forward to take part in one of the 11+ Scholarship assessments, please contact the Admissions office (prepadmissions@cliftoncollege.com) prior to the relevant application deadline date.

Please note that the Scholarships programme runs alongside the means-tested bursary programme. Those receiving a scholarship will be able to apply for a bursary if they need assistance in paying school fees. 11+ Sport Scholarships

The 11+ Sport Scholarship is open to candidates who offer exceptional talent in more than one team sport. Successful candidates will display all the necessary attributes of a talented sports person: speed, agility, coordination, power, endurance, coach-ability and desire.

Completed application forms must be received by the Admissions office no later than Friday 20th November 2020, application forms are available from the Admissions office. Assessments will take place on Friday 4th December 2020. Shortlisted candidates will then have an interview on the 10th December 2020. The Assessment Day will consist of fitness and games assessments in the morning and then a games afternoon to include match play.

For top performers 11+ Sports Scholarships are available until the end of Year 11, conditional upon the boy or girl playing a full role in the sporting life of Clifton College. All 11+ Sport Scholarship winners will take part in the 13+ Sports Scholarship assessments and based on their performance at the 13+ assessments the Scholarship may be extended to the end of the Sixth Form.

11+ Academic Scholarship

Candidates are required to sit written papers in English and Mathematics, as well as complete an online cognitive ability test. We expect that the pupils sitting the Scholarship exams are

performing at well above the expected National Curriculum Level for their age group in English and Mathematics and are demonstrating significant potential across the curriculum.

The deadline for applications is Monday 4th January 2021, please contact our Admissions office (prepadmissions@cliftoncollege.com) if you would like to put your child forward. Assessments will take place on Monday 11th January 2021. Shortlisted candidates will then have an interview on the 18th January 2021.

For top performers, 11+ Academic Scholarships are available to last for the duration of the pupil's time at Clifton College in the Prep and Upper Schools, conditional upon the boy or girl maintaining high academic standards.

11+ Music Scholarships

Music Scholarships are examined by audition and interview. Candidates should offer two instruments with the principal being of Grade 4 or above standard. They will be asked to perform two contrasting pieces on their main instrument and must be able to perform well on their second instrument and may offer singing as well. Importance is attached to sight reading, tests of musical interest and intelligence, scales and aural tests. It is stressed that we are looking for potential. It may be the case that a candidate has only reached Grade 3, but in a very short space of time. Consideration would be given to such circumstances.

Completed application forms must be received by the Admissions Office no later than Friday 29th January 2021. Application forms are available from the Admissions office (prepadmissions@cliftoncollege.com). The assessment date is Friday 5th February 2021, candidates will also have an interview.

For top performers 11+ Music Scholarships are available for the duration of the pupil's time at Clifton College in the Prep and Upper Schools, conditional upon the boy or girl playing a full role in the musical life of Clifton College.
