

13+ Scholarship Examination

Art

Time allowed: Three hours.

- Candidates for the art scholarship attend the art department at a date set in February to present a portfolio to the Director of Art. On this day they are also asked to sit an observational drawing exam lasting for an hour and a half followed by a colour test for an hour and a half. The Headmaster also interviews them.
- Enthusiasm, expertise and potential are qualities expected of art scholars. A love of art should be apparent in their portfolio and in their attitude to the tasks set as well as in the interview. They should be keen to promote art within the college and set an example of excellence to their peers.
- Discussion with the Headmaster leads to the selection of award winners who are notified in writing thereafter.
